

New Personal Technology Policy:

- Personal technology (cell phones, headphones/AirPods, smartwatches, etc.) is not allowed in any classroom on campus
- Students may only use their personal technology before and after school and in the cafeteria at lunch.

Disciplinary Actions:

Upon entering the classroom, all personal technology should be secured, turned off and in your backpack. If students fail to do so the teacher will enter a personal technology violation referral into Skyward and the following will occur:

- 1st offense: visible personal technology is taken up and turned in to the office; student or parent may pick up for a \$15.00 fee AND one (1) day detention
- 2nd offense: visible personal technology is taken up and turned in to the office; student or parent may pick up for a \$15.00 fee AND two (2) days detention
- 3rd offense: visible personal technology is taken up and turned in to the office; student or parent may pick up for a \$15.00 fee AND Saturday school
- 4th offense: visible personal technology is taken up and turned in to the office; student or parent may pick up for a \$15.00 fee AND ISS (min. 5 days)

Refusal to surrender device(s):

- 1st offense: the student will be assigned ISS (min. 5 days) and charged a \$15.00 fee
- 2nd offense: the student will be assigned ISS (10 days), charged a \$15.00 fee, assigned Saturday school, and a parent/guardian conference will take place
- 3rd offense: PACE placement

Cell phones will be returned at the end of the day, after the fee has been paid.
